COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

This scholarship was developed to demonstrate Skyland Grain's commitment to the communities of Southwest Kansas, South Central Kansas, Southeast Colorado, and the Oklahoma Panhandle. The scholarships are available for students attending a two or four year college. The student must be a graduating senior who is involved in pursuing an agriculture or business related education.

CONDITIONS OF THE PROGRAM

1. To be eligible for consideration for these scholarships, students must provide the following:
2. Have a cumulative seventh semester GPA of at least 3.25 on a 4.0 scale
3. Have minimum ACT composite score of 20 or SAT-I combined score of 1020
4. A one-page essay responding to the statements listed below:
 - a. Discuss your future educational and career goals.
 - b. Describe examples of your leadership experience in which you have significantly influenced others and helped resolve conflicts. Consider responsibilities to initiatives taken in or out of school.
5. Completed application to include Guidance Counselor Section.
6. A letter of reference from a school official (counselor, teacher, principal, club sponsor etc.)
7. Be a resident of our service areas in Southwest Kansas, South Central Kansas, Southeast Colorado, and the Oklahoma Panhandle.
8. Include a picture. If you are selected we will feature you in our annual meeting program, as well as ask that you attend one of the annual meetings either in Johnson (May 21st, 2019), or Cunningham, KS (May 17th, 2019).

DESCRIPTION OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD AND PAYMENT OF FUNDS

Recipients have the opportunity to receive up to \$4,000.00 during their four year college education. The funds will be distributed equally (\$1,000.00) each continuous academic school year with the initial funds distributed with recipient providing a copy of their college enrollment form to Teresa Hammond at Skyland Grain, LLC, 202 S. Main St., Johnson, KS 67855. Then prior to the beginning of each school year thereafter recipient will provide a copy of their college enrollment form and copy of previous year's GPA of 2.5 or greater to be eligible for scholarship funds for the upcoming academic school year.

Applications must be postmarked or in the counselor office by April 1, 2019.
